He had a dream when he was little that he wanted to help people, toward the end of 2012 Greg joined the local fire company as a volunteer fire fighter. Greg studied for endless hours putting his all into becoming an amazing role model for our girls by his drills, and tests passing all his certifications. Greg always worked extremely hard to make sure we had everything we needed and wanted, as well as coming home from work every night and spending hours playing outside with the girls and coloring with them showing them exactly what a dad is suppose to be like.

I have known Greg since the young age of 15 when we starting dating. We were completely inseparable and did everything we could together. I knew after the first couple weeks how incredible of a person he was when he helped me tremendously when I had family issues of my own he supported me in every way he could and drove be back and forth to school every day.
